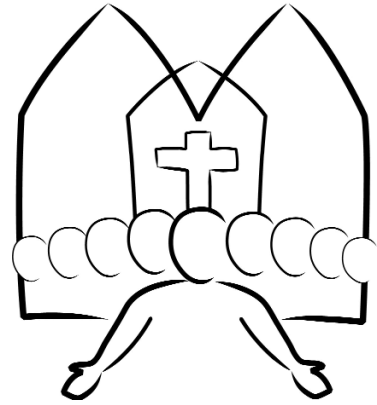


# Renewal
